What's New @LMC?



The Bay Restaurant and Bay School of Hospitality

We are launching our new **Bay School of Hospitality**, in partnership with the team at **Gilpin** as they become our Ambassador for Hospitality. The partnership with the Gilpin team coincides with a complete rebrand of LMC's catering and hospitality offer and the opening of our new **The Bay Restaurant** (formerly Coulson's) in late autumn. Adult learners on part-time courses will have the opportunity to take part in a **Chefs' Challenge Award** to showcase their skills.

Clinical Skills Ward

The clinical skills room has been **developed to replicate a hospital ward**, and is fully equipped with nursing patient care simulators, a CPR training manikin that measures, monitors and analyses the performance of trainees, and equipment for cardiovascular monitoring and patient observations. The room will allow all healthcare students to prepare for placements and employment and develop practical skills relating to the healthcare sector.



Sustainable LMC

In 2022, LMC successfully secured funding to create a **Sustainable Energy Hub** and **Renewable Energy Demonstration Centre** on campus, as part of our continued commitment to promoting sustainable careers across the region. Our state-of-the-art, **fully-immersive Virtual Reality suite** and two new **CAD workshops** opened in November 2022, providing our students with enhanced learning opportunities. We will be launching a new qualification, **TQUK Level 4 Certificate in Teaching and Learning for Sustainable Development**, later in the year.

In July, we were pleased to learn we had been awarded funding by the world-renowned, renewable energy company **Orsted**, to develop a demonstration centre in the Hub promoting awareness of green technologies and STEM-related activities, which will be accessible to local primary and secondary schools.

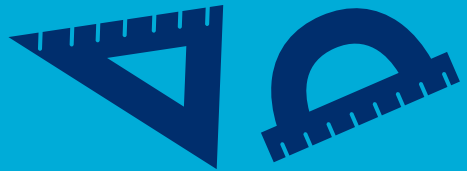

Maths & English

No matter which course you take at LMC, our aim is to help you progress into your chosen career and the majority of employers now look for a minimum GCSE grade 4/C or Functional Skills L2 in Maths & English.

At LMC, we offer two levels in each subject; **GCSE** and **Functional Skills**.



Maths

Functional Skills Maths classes teach learners to the standard required to achieve up to a Functional Skills Level 2. Functional Skills Maths qualifications are very different to Maths GCSE exams, as they focus more on Maths skills for the workplace.

GCSE 4/5 Maths teaches learners to the standard required to achieve a GCSE grade 4 or 5 on the Foundation Paper. All learners will sit the GCSE exams in May/June. Learners with a GCSE grade 3 will be placed in these classes.



English

Functional Skills English classes teach learners to the standard required to achieve up to a Functional Skills Level 2. Functional Skills English qualifications are very different to English Language GCSE exams, as they focus more on English skills for the workplace.

GCSE English classes teach learners to the standard required to achieve a GCSE grade 4 or 5, and the exam papers allow all grades up to Grade 9 to be achieved. All learners will sit the GCSE exams in May/June. Learners with a GCSE grade 3 will be placed in these classes.

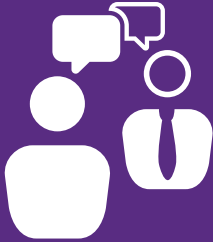
