Our courses offer you academic progression, so we have a course for you wherever your starting point. This page is designed to help you decide which is the right choice for you, based on our course entry requirements.

Entry Level

No formal qualifications.

Level 1

3 GCSEs at grade G/1 or higher plus grade F/2 or higher in English or maths.

Level 3

5 GCSEs at grade C/4 or higher including English and maths OR a Level 2 related qualification PLUS grade C/4 or higher in both English and maths.

Level 2

4 GCSEs at grade D/3 or higher including English or maths OR a Level 1 related qualification PLUS grade D/3 or higher in English or maths.

Level 4

From 64 UCAS points dependant on course PLUS grade C/4 or higher in both GCSE English and maths. Advanced Apprenticeship or equivalent experience.

Level 5

From 64 UCAS points dependant on course PLUS grade C/4 or higher in both GCSE English and maths. Advanced Apprenticeship or equivalent experience.



Students aged 19+ may be entitled to study for free, depending upon their individual circumstances; contact the Student Money advisors to discuss this further.

Advanced Learner Loans

Advanced Learner Loans may be available for adult learners studying a Level 3 course. The loan covers tuition fees for students aged 19 or older who are studying further education courses at Level 3 and above. The loan is not means-tested and repayments only start after completing your course and earnings are over £25,000 per annum.

If you are under 24 and studying your first full Level 3, it is likely to be FREE.




