- Anyone with any potential Covid (including cold type symptoms) MUST NOT attend site and should take a PCR test

Lancaster &

Morecambe College

- Remote education/home work will be available for those who test positive or must isolate
- Inform covidresponse@lmc.ac.uk if you test positive or are required to isolate
- Close contacts will be required to follow the self-isolation requirements issued on 16 August
- We strongly recommend that all eligible members of the college community have 2 vaccinations and any booster jabs as soon as possible
- The whole College community to continue twice-weekly home-testing
- Home-test kits are available on campus
- Frequent handwashing/sanitising to continue
- Face coverings to be worn in shared use internal areas
- Where possible you should avoid unnecessary close contact with others
- Continued enhanced cleaning schedule across College
- Each room will continue to have a hygiene/ cleaning kit
- One-way systems will still be in use in blocks, C, D and S

Covid Status is AMBER

AMBER controls when the College is made aware of a statistically significant increase in positive cases affecting some parts of the College community by the Lancashire Public Health Team.

ALL GREEN CONTROLS APPLY, AND:

- Reintroduction of social distancing as required
- Reintroduction of bubbles as required
- Reintroduction of remote learning as required
- Further additional controls for clinically vulnerable and clinically extremely vulnerable people
- Cancellation/postponement of activities such as onsite open days, course trips & visits etc



RED controls when the College is required to significantly change its activities due to contact from the Lancashire Public Health Team or National Government

- Social distancing required
- Bubbles required
- Remote learning required
- Shielding for clinically and clinically extremely vulnerable people
- Cancellation/postponement of activities
