Recruitment Support

We offer a dedicated **Apprenticeship Vacancy Service**, where we match potential employees to the right business and we can promote your vacancies to applicants across Cumbria and Lancashire. Depending upon the age of the apprentice, you may be eligible for £1,000 funding.
