Management & Leadership Academy

Upskill your team in management and leadership skills with recognised qualifications and development opportunities in team leading and operations.

Team Leader Level 3

This apprenticeship introduces you to different leadership styles, organisational cultures and team management models, as well as the importance of personal and professional development as a first-line manager. This is a practical programme, suitable for a Team Leader or Supervisor who has responsibility for managing a team.

Operations/Departmental Manager Level 5

An Operations or Departmental Manager is someone who manages a team and supports the wider business in the completion of projects and meeting operational or departmental goals and objectives. Leadership and management skills have a major impact on the development, productivity and performance of organisations. This Level 5 apprenticeship will equip learners to develop skills in strategic planning, alongside core leadership abilities.
