LMC celebrate GOOD Ofsted inspection grade

Staff, students and Governors at Lancaster & Morecambe College (LMC) are celebrating their latest Ofsted inspection which graded the College as GOOD across all areas, and commended the strong contribution LMC makes to meeting skills needs across the region.

A team of 11 inspectors spent four days on the campus in early February and undertook a comprehensive inspection of all aspects of College life, concluding that LMC provides an ambitious curriculum setting consistently high standards, and that students enjoy attending classes and feel supported and respected by College staff.

Daniel Braithwaite, LMC's Principal, is justifiably proud of the report, where inspectors highlighted the friendly and supportive culture which helps prepare students to progress into further study, onto employment or into higher education.

I am extremely proud of our students, staff and stakeholders of the College and this has been endorsed by our fantastic Ofsted report. It is a powerful validation of our collective hard work and commitment to the communities we serve. There are some amazing statements within the report that highlight how our learners feel about their learning, development and support received from staff at our college. Employers and wider stakeholders also provided Ofsted with some fantastic feedback on how we work in partnership to meet their needs, leading to recognition of our strong contribution to meeting skills needs at a local, regional and national level.

The inspection team met a wide range of students and apprentices during their four day visit, including a number of adult learners, and were impressed with their commitment and enthusiasm.

Learners and apprentices are proud of the knowledge, skills and behaviours that they develop.

Staff were praised for setting consistent expectations on the

behaviours and attitudes needed for life and work, and for developing meaningful and relevant work experience opportunities for learners.

As part of the new inspection framework, the College was assessed on how well it meets local, regional and national skills needs and it received the highest accolade, with LMC's contribution rated as STRONG.

Staff work highly effectively with an extensive network of employers to develop tailored training and education programmes... and play a key role leading on the sustainability and green skills agenda in the region."

This was reflected in the positive feedback Ofsted received from local employers, with one stating that

Lancaster & Morecambe College speaks the language of business.

During the inspection, surveys were sent out on behalf of Ofsted to LMC learners, their parents and carers, adult students, regional employers, College staff and community stakeholders to gather their feedback on the College. The feedback was overwhelmingly positive, with

- 95% of current students saying that they would recommend LMC to their friends.
- 93% of staff stating that they were proud to work at College.

Hilary Fordham, LMC's Chair of Governors, was equally pleased with the inspection report.

We are incredibly proud of what is achieved by all, and so pleased that this has been recognised by Ofsted. We will continue to support the team in the work they do so that the College continues to offer such great opportunities to our whole community.

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Philip Dunn Courses Taken: Teaching Assistant Level 3 Apprenticeship

Profession: Higher Level Teaching Assistant

Philip found his way onto the Teaching Assistant Level 3 Apprenticeship at Ripley St Thomas Church of England School with LMC later in life as a result of wanting a career change. He says that the Apprenticeship opportunity came about almost by accident.

One day I picked my children up from school and was thinking what a nice job the Teaching Assistants have. That same day, my wife came back from work, and said she had been chatting about me being a Teaching Assistant.

Philip's career route after school had taken a very different pathway, as he went to college to resit his English GCSE. Once he had passed that, he then went on to do a BTEC Business course and progressed onto university to a Degree in Event Management. He struggled with learning throughout his school life, and at university was diagnosed with Dyslexia. Once he left university, he then worked for a variety of companies in various events-related roles.

Philip applied for the Teaching Assistant Apprenticeship at Ripley St Thomas Church of England School, and to his surprise, was offered the job, which was the first step into his new career. In his role, Philip has the opportunity to work with pupils from Year 7 up to Year 13, across a wide range of subjects.

I have such an amazing time doing my Apprenticeship at a high school, as every day is different.

The Teaching Assistant Apprenticeship has helped Philip professionally by giving him the courage to change his career, as it provided him with the skills and experience to do a job in a new field of work. Since finishing the Apprenticeship, he has applied for and started a new role as a Higher Level Teaching Assistant, which would not have been possible without the qualifications he gained through the Apprenticeship.

Course Funding & Finance

Many of our learners study for FREE!

Don't be put off by the cost of studying, many of our learners study for free. Eligibility depends on your individual circumstances and the course you have chosen to study.

You may also be able to access the Learner Support Fund for financial support for some of the additional costs when studying, whether that is travel costs, equipment or uniform for your course or childcare costs.

You may also be eligible for FREE study if you are unemployed and receive an eligible benefit and you are taking the course to help you find employment. You may be eligible for a subsidised rate of £25 per course if you are employed and in receipt of certain benefits – look for courses marked with ♦ throughout this course guide.

Can I study for free?

If you are studying a legal entitlement course such as English, Maths or Essential Digital Skills - Entry Level, Level 1, or Level 2, or are unemployed, or earn less than £25,000 gross salary, then the answer is YES! When you enrol, you will need to provide evidence of your salary or benefits.

If you have achieved the qualification to be studied previously, or have an existing qualification at a higher level, then fees will apply.

What if I need to take out a loan?

Advanced Learner Loans are also available for eligible courses and available to anyone over the age of 19, regardless of individual circumstances, studying Level 3 or Level 4 courses. The loan will fully cover your fees and will only need to be repaid when you earn over a certain threshold and subject to the payment plan assigned. More information is provided on application for the Advanced Learner Loan.

What if I need to pay for the course?

If the course is available for online enrolment, you can pay online as part of the enrolment process. You can also pay by cash or card in the Hex or by phoning our Finance team on 01524 521205.

Will I be entitled to any financial help while studying at College?

You may be entitled to financial support while you are studying, through the College's Learner Support Fund. Help is available with transport, uniform and kit costs and childcare. It is easy to apply via our Pay My Student digital portal.

What are Tailored Learning or UKSPF courses?

Tailored Learning are non qualification based courses that offer an introduction into courses. They can be free or at a very low cost depending on your financial situation. UKSPF courses are FREE to anyone who lives in a LA post code regardless of income.

What about Level 3 courses or above?

Our Level 3 courses will be free if you are studying one of the courses in the box and meet the criteria below:

- Aged 19+ earning under £25,000 gross salary regardless of prior attainment
- When you enrol, you will need to provide evidence of your salary
 - Understanding Mental Health
 Level 3 NCFE Certificate
 - Understanding Autism
 Level 3 NCFE Certificate
 - Understanding Principles of Dementia Care Level 3 NCFE
 - AAT Accounting Level 3 Diploma
 - Hospitality & Supervision
 Level 3 CGLI NVQ Diploma
 - Early Residential Childcare Level 3 TQUK Diploma
 - Lead Adult Care
 Level 3 NCFE Diploma

If you are studying for a Level 3 that is not in the list/is not available on the Legal Entitlement list, or you do not meet the eligibility criteria, you will be required to take out an Advanced Learner Loan.

Having left school without achieving any of my GCSEs and being informed that I had severe dyslexia, I decided to apply to study various Adult Education courses at college whilst working a number of part-time jobs. At that time, I didn't really have a career path in mind, but knew that if I gained my GCSEs this would be a good starting point.



College was very different to school, studying alongside other adults suited my style of learning. The tutors were more aware of my learning needs and were very supportive. I also utilised the learning support that was offered to me by attending group workshops and 1:1 sessions, where I was provided with tips and guidance on how to improve my work.

After successfully gaining my GCSEs, I progressed onto a Level 3 qualification, and from that point on there was no stopping me. I eventually decided to go into teaching as I wanted to help others with learning difficulties to have the opportunity to achieve.

Courses taken: ESOL, Functional Skills Maths & English, AAT Accounting Level 3

After relocating to Morecambe in 2022, Alemayehu joined LMC through Global Link and enrolled onto ESOL, Functional Skills Maths ϑ English, and then progressed to the AAT Accounting Level 3,.

The AAT Accounting course is designed to ensure students are prepared to progress onto a career in the business world or even onto further education and studies.

LMC emerged as the perfect fit for my academic journey as they offer a program that seamlessly transitioned from my functional skills studies into an AAT Accounting qualification. The knowledge I gain from studying this course is very valuable as it allows me to build a strong foundation of knowledge as well as handling my practical skills.

Studying these courses allows Alemayehu to build a strong skill set which he can carry into his future career.

In my accounting qualification, I gain proficiency in accounting principles, bookkeeping practices and financial analysis methods. With functional skills, I am improving my communication and critical thinking which are valuable skills to have.

Alemayehu is close to finishing his Functional Skills English Level 2 and his AAT Accounting Level 3 which are going to be great accomplishments for him. When asked what he would say to someone thinking of doing these courses, Alemayehu said:

I would first say identify the areas you are interested in to ensure the course is the right option for you, explore all your options and then apply. Once you apply for the course College assists you with anything you need allowing a seamless process. After this course, I will join the employment market and find the best job for me. I hope to continue my studies throughout my career too.

Courses taken: Distance Learning, GCSE Maths, GCSE Biology, Access To HE

Profession: Pursuing a career in midwifery

Tanya was initially introduced to learning at LMC through our Distance Learning courses. These are free online courses allowing you to fit your learning around other commitments such as your work and home life.

Choosing to study at LMC was the best choice for me, especially as a single mum. I am aiming to study midwifery, and I would not be able to do that without completing the distance learning courses first.

Tanya then completed GCSEs in Maths & Biology, before enrolling onto the Access to HE course in September 2024.

The courses have provided Tanya with the knowledge she needs to continue her studies, and she then plans to apply to study midwifery at university.

I love that I have gained all this knowledge as I know it is going to help me with my future career. I have met some wonderful people along the way at LMC, from staff to my fellow students.

As well as gaining the technical knowledge required to pass the exams, Tanya has also gained soft skills such as time management and communication.

Time management has always been something I struggled with and through these courses I have been able to improve this skill. I have also learnt how to effectively work within a group and adapt to a busy environment.

My advice to anyone thinking of studying any of the Distance Learning courses or GCSE courses, would be to definitely give it a try! No matter what your situation, the staff at College are always there to help.





Maths/English & Digital Skills

Don't have your Maths, English or Digital qualifications? Don't let that hold you back...

We offer FREE Maths, English and Digital workshops on the main College campus, at The Link at West Street and out in the community at venues such as Morecambe Library, Brew Me Sunshine in Morecambe and Cornerstones in Lancaster. Join our workshops to achieve new skills in order for you to be able to progress in work, life or to university. The classes are timetabled to fit around family and work commitments. Functional Workshops are available where we offer Functional Maths and Functional English from Entry 1 – Level 2.

The Essential Digital Skills course is designed to support the development of digital skills required for everyday life, work and further study and includes internet safety/cyber security. It provides a nationally recognised digital skills qualification and is a step towards further study. We offer Essential Digital Skills at Entry 3 and Level 1 alongside Level 2 Digital and IT Skills Award, which give you the opportunity to develop your Word and Excel skills.

Apprenticeships

A growing number of adults are selecting apprenticeships as a means to gain the essential knowledge, skills, and industry experience required for starting a new career or advancing in their current roles. Apprenticeships combine practical training in a job with study. As an apprentice, you'll be an employee earning a wage; work alongside experienced staff; gain job-specific skills; and get time for training and study related to your role. They take 1-5 years to complete depending on their level.

MYTH 1: Apprenticeships are only for school leavers

REALITY: Apprenticeships are open to individuals of all ages. Whether you are 16 or 60, there are no age restrictions when it comes to pursuing an apprenticeship. The opportunities that apprenticeships offer are available to anyone willing to invest in their personal and professional development, regardless of their age.

MYTH 2: Apprenticeships are for people who aren't academic

REALITY: This is not true. Apprenticeships are an alternative route into employment and those choosing this route are ambitious and keen to earn while they learn. Many simply prefer the hands-on experience that an apprenticeship can bring.

MYTH 3: Apprenticeships are all low paid

REALITY: Although there is a National Minimum Wage for apprentices set annually, this is a minimum an employer can pay, and many more employers will pay significantly more. They give people the chance to bring home a salary while they learn and build a platform for their career.

MYTH 4: Apprenticeships are only available in certain sectors

REALITY: The days when apprenticeships were available only in certain industries like construction and manufacturing are long gone. They're now available in a huge range of sectors, like finance, hospitality, education, business and management.

MYTH 5: An apprenticeship will limit my future career prospects

REALITY: Apprenticeships can take you right to the top of an organisation. Employers increasingly value apprenticeships as a viable career route. It means applicants have real experience of the workplace and, at the end, often a qualification too. Most employers look at someone's experience and their qualifications - an apprenticeship delivers both.

MYTH 6: If I do an apprenticeship, I'll get stuck in one job

REALITY: Apprenticeships are available in a variety of industries and equip you with the transferable skills that employers from many different sectors will value. Some apprenticeships offer the opportunity to work in different parts of a business too, which allows you to experience various roles and find what you enjoy doing. An apprenticeship is a foot in the door and can open up many exciting new career paths.

MYTH 8: I'll be making tea all the time

REALITY: Apprenticeships provide valuable work experience and training in a real job environment. While there may be occasional tasks like making tea for colleagues, apprentices are integral team members with real responsibilities. Employers invest in apprentices by providing them with meaningful work that contributes to the organisation, helping them develop essential skills and knowledge for future career growth.





Sean Lonsdale

Courses taken: Production Chef Level 2 Apprenticeship, and Senior Production Chef Level 3 Apprenticeship

Profession: Catering Assistant at Lancaster & Morecambe College

Sean chose to do the Production Chef Level 2 Apprenticeship with LMC as he thought it would be a great way to learn more skills and techniques in the hospitality and catering industry, whilst also getting paid to do a job that he thoroughly enjoyed.

I liked each part of the job, but the area that I enjoyed most and still do, is working on the pass. I find that being able to make a dish look amazing is one of the best parts of the job.

After Sean finished the Level 2 Apprenticeship at LMC, he progressed onto the Level 3 Apprenticeship, and was offered a full time position within the Catering department and taken on as a member of staff as an Apprentice.

The most enjoyable part of the Apprenticeship is being able to learn whilst on the job, being hands on instead of sitting in a classroom as well as getting paid to learn.

All of the staff in the department are really supportive, and always happy to help in any situation with advice and encouragement, whether it's teaching me new skills, supporting me with my theory work or developing new ideas on plating dishes.

Sean has steadily learnt more skills as he progresses through the Apprenticeships, initially, his job was mainly just prepping in the kitchen, but as he developed more skills, he became more involved in ordering the stock and helping supervise students and kitchens. The teaching and supporting the students Sean really enjoys and he is now considering the idea of moving into teaching in the future, a career he had never considered until he started the Apprenticeships at College.

Courses taken: CMI Leadership & Management Level 5 and Operational Department Manager Level 5 Apprenticeship

Profession: Regional Director, Westmorland Homecare

Daniel came to LMC in 2022 to study on our Leadership & Management course as well as undertaking an Operational Department Manager Level 5 Apprenticeship, in order to strengthen his skills and increase his career prospects.

I chose to study at LMC due to its lovely reputation, the fact it is easily accessible and also the wide range of courses offered for continuous professional development. My apprenticeship was amazing, I enjoyed working with such a lovely group and the amazing teaching and mentoring from our outstanding tutor - Gill!

Since achieving qualifications in both courses, Daniel has been promoted to a Regional Director in the company! Both courses provide you with the knowledge, skills and behaviours you will need to lead and manage in a variety of settings.

During his apprenticeship, Daniel feels he developed his skills in six key areas: leadership & management, operational skills, finance, communication, problemsolving and strategic planning. He oversees all aspects of the branch including HR, marketing, finance, recruitment and training. His role has enabled the branch to flourish.

Having studied at LMC as a student herself, Beth is fully aware of the great opportunities available at the College. My first major job in the industry was on the hit Netflix series 'Heartstopper'. After that I jumped onto another Netflix Show 'Half Bad'. I then went onto the BBC comedy 'Ghosts' and here I really started to build my confidence.

Thea got offered the opportunity to work on the final series of 'The Crown', where she was able to learn from her talented co-workers the art of period styles.

It was an amazing and surreal experience, 9 months of visiting every stately home in the country. I learned from some of the most talented women in the industry the art of period styling.

Thea's advice for anyone thinking of a career within the Hair & Media Make- up industry is:

I would say to anyone wanting to start a career in the Film and TV industry, if you are serious and committed to it then go for it!

Frequently Asked Questions...

How do I enrol?

Once you have been interviewed and offered a place, log on to your College Prospect account and complete the next sections. If you need to pay for your course, you can do so in person with Student Money in The Hex.

How many days will I be in College?

Most of our part time courses are one evening a week, or one half day a week. The Access courses are classed as full time courses and are over three days a week but your tutor will share the timetable with you at interview.

What support can I get from College if I'm struggling?

We have a wealth of support at College including our Pastoral Mentors, Safeguarding Manager, Additional Learning Support, Student Money team as well as extra support from your tutor themselves.

What happens if I don't have access to a computer at home?

The College has laptops that we can lend you for the period of time you are on the course. You also have free access to the computers in The Hex.

How much does it cost?

Many of our adult courses will be FREE or at a reduced cost depending on your financial situation. Further information about course costs can be found on page 6. We also have a Student Money team who can be contacted on 01524 521469 if you want to ask a specific question.

What happens if I miss a class?

Don't worry! If you are going to miss a session, please let your tutor know as soon as is possible. You will then be able to catch up; your tutor may send you work via email or MS Teams or share it with you the following week.

What other qualifications do I need?

For many of our part time courses, you do not need to have any qualifications before you start learning with us. If you are not sure, please contact us to have a chat. All learners will complete an assessment in the first few weeks of the course to make sure the level of the course is right for you.

What are the class sizes?

The average adult class is 10-12 for our part time classes but may be higher on very popular courses.
