IOSH Managing Safely

This course is an introduction to the fundamentals of health and safety management in the workplace. It is aimed at all employees in any organisation, but particularly team leaders, supervisors and managers. This course will providing the knowledge, skills and confidence to contribute towards an organisation's health and safety agenda.

The course is arranged into seven modules:

- Introducing managing safely
- Understanding your responsibilities
- Identifying hazards
- Assessing risks
- Controlling risks
- Investigating accidents and incidents
- Measuring performance.

There are no entry requirements for this certificate, however it is important that you have a suitable standard of English language in order to understand and articulate the concepts contained in the course. To achieve your IOSH Managing safely certificate you must complete a 30-question exam and a worked based risk assessment.
