This will include a new nuclear focused HNC Engineering*, Level 3 Nuclear Engineering and Science* and a range of 'nuclear behaviours' modules embedded into the existing curriculum.

The provision will be truly employer-led and will provide unique career progression pathways to degree level apprenticeships in partnership with EDF Energy and the National College for Nuclear.
